St John's musical programme is underpinned by our annual Choral Scholarship Scheme. Through a local charity, the William Gibbs Religious and Educational Trust, we support eight top postgraduate vocal students from renowned London music colleges (the Royal College and Royal Academy of Music, Guildhall School and Trinity College) who are already well established as recitalists and oratorio singers and can often be spotted on stage with Glyndebourne, Garsington and other world-class opera companies.

The variety and quality of St John's music is augmented by our recently-restored pipe organ and our professional orchestra, led by Jonathan Hill, a prolific performer and recording artist who also leads the band of Les Miserables in the West End. We use different combinations of instruments each week, from soloists to string quartets to full orchestra; all of our players are active with major London orchestras.
